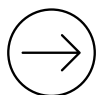

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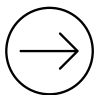
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## **GROUP: STUDY**

5. Imagine the scene at the Pharisee's house – what would you have felt and thought when you saw a known sinful woman come into the house, go to Jesus, weep at his feet, wipe his feet with her hair, and then anoint them?
6. What is the main point of this passage?
