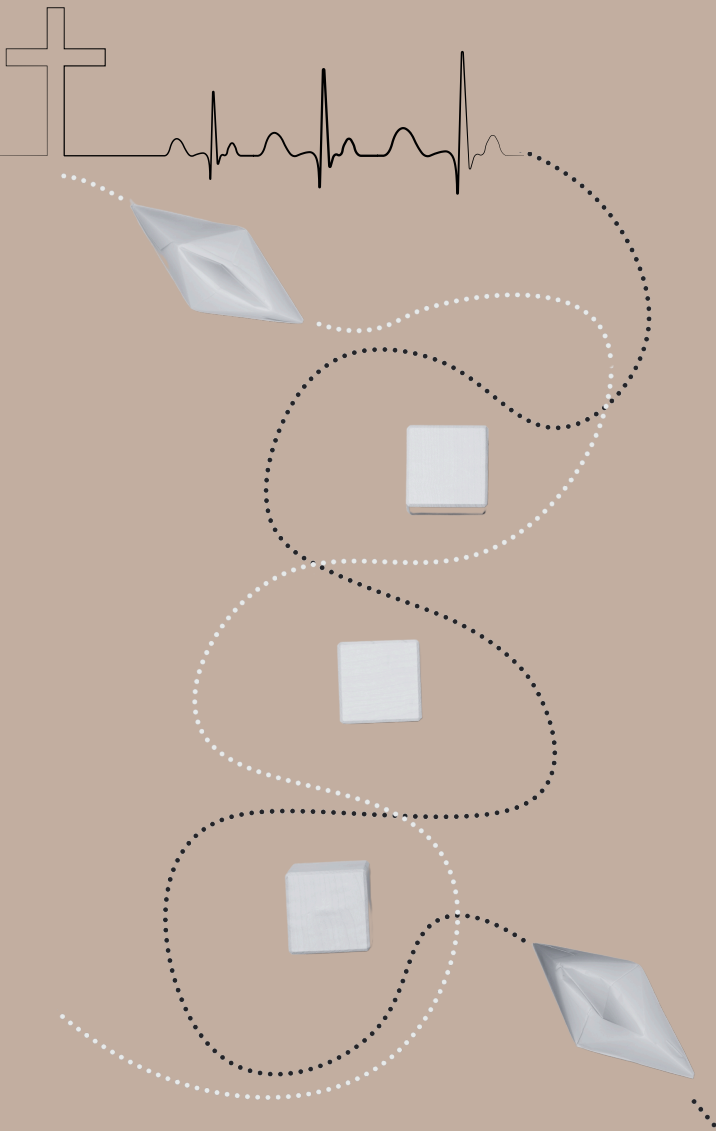

What is the Purpose or Meaning of Life?

Everyone views and experiences life through a set of lenses or worldviews. Philosopher James Sire argues that "everyone holds to certain presuppositions, which we hold to consciously or subconsciously, consistently or inconsistently, about the basic constitution of reality, and that provides foundation on which we live."

For Christians, we hold a biblical worldview, whereby we define reality through gospel lenses. In our lesson, we will see from Scripture that the meaning of life is to know God in Jesus Christ and to become like him. Secondly, we will consider things that flow out of gospel living. What did Paul mean when he said, "conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel?" In other words, what are some tangible evidences that God is at work in us? Lastly, we will examine how God molds and shapes us to become more like Jesus, so we are never caught off guard when God's refining fire purifies us.
