- We confess Him in our hymns, doxology, creed, sacraments, and liturgy.









**Message:** Jesus is both God and man, our sole mediator with God, be drawn to Him more and more (from DFD Leader's Guide)

- He is fully God because the Father's testified of Him in the Scripture, empowered His earthly life through His Spirit, resurrected and exalted Him to the highest throne in heaven.



The Holy Spirit points only to Christ, joins us to Christ's Body, applies and fills us to the brim with all of the blood-bought blessings of Christ.



# Book 1 Message: We Can Love and Trust God Because


- The Father loves us and sent us His Son







#### **Fellowship**—Connecting to Christ through His Body

- 1Jn 1:3 that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ.
- Eph 4:15-16 Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way **into him who is the head, into Christ**,
- from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love.
